

Verbs pantomime

What do you need for this game?

Verb cards, pantomime actors, cardholder

Participants: the whole group

Language aims:

Recognizing verbs as types of words, development of imagination and perception.

First, the teacher prepares cards with verbs.

Then, the cardholder explains to the players that they will take one card to themselves and read the verb.

After that, the student needs to think about how to act it out like pantomime actor with their body in place or in motion. Then students show it in front of the group. The task for the group is to guess the verb.

When the group figures out the verb, the first player leaves the card on separate deck.

Every player goes individually to take one new card, display the default verb from the card.

Take turns until you run out of cards.
