

Erasmus Mascot 3 "VACCA CINISARA"

Materials

Old newspapers, white glue, water colours

First, tear the newspapers into many pieces or irregular strips.

Then let them soak in a mix of white glue and water.

After that, cover the whole shape with the soaked paper.

Let it dry. The average time is 24 hours, but will always depend on temperature in the room.

After 2 days another layer of newspaper and glue is applied again to make it more resistant.

When dried apply a white paint on the entire template to isolate it.

At the end complete the work using tempera colors.

Observation

This technique is used in Italian schools during the Carnival period to build allegorical floats.

Key objective

Develop creativity using different materials around a given topic.
